Students will be tested in Fall, Winter, and Spring.

- Any student who tests in the 75th percentile in the Winter or Spring will be given full credit for our data.
- Any student who meets, or exceeds, their projected growth during the Winter or Spring will be given full credit for our data.
- Any student who begins the school year above grade level, ends the school year above grade level, and shows growth for the school year will be given full credit for our data.
- Students who do not meet their projected growth but do show growth will earn a half credit for our data. Growth must be present from the fall to the spring test.
- Any student who exhibits chronic absenteeism may be excluded from our growth data. For our
 data, chronic absenteeism will be defined as a student who misses <u>24 days</u> of instruction for any
 reason (excluding snow days) between the beginning of the year and the spring test may be
 excluded from our local data.
